Dear Prayer Team,

I hope all of you had a joyful Christmas and a Happy New Year. My first week back in the United States was a whirlwind with doctor appointments and visiting my former school, Seven Rivers Christian School. It was exciting to hear from the students how they had been praying for me, making and selling lemonade to help with my support. Thanks to those who have been drinking all that lemonade. I am amazed as I watch God provide for unexpected expenses even before I know the extra money is needed. He truly has provided for every need. And, I know He will provide for the one I am sharing with you in this letter. I need your prayers!

Since the preschools and elementary schools I will be working with are spread out across Belize, I will need to have my own vehicle. I have been approved to purchase a vehicle but MTW funds are not allowed to be used for the purchases of cars. While in Belize I was able to do some research into the prices of vehicles. I need to raise \$15,000 to \$20,000 for the purchase of a car. These are used 1995-1997 vehicles. Would you please pray for God's provision of a car?
