Family practice or internal medicine physician (willing to see pediatric patients) needed at the Presbyterian Medical Clinic in Belize, Central America as of June 1st, 2009. Medical and conversational Spanish ability is preferred but not required. Visitors are welcome for various lengths of stay beginning with one week, but a one year commitment is desired.

The Belize clinic would also welcome visiting Gynecologists, Dermatologists, Pediatricians, Ophthalmologists and Optometrists. Dentists are needed once a month.

The Presbyterian Medical Clinic is a ministry of the Presbyterian Church in Belize which desires to assist in church growth by ministering health to the church members and evangelizing the un-reached through medical ministry. The Presbyterian Church in Belize is an evangelical church who partners with Mission to the World, the mission arm of the Presbyterian Church in America, also an evangelical denomination in the USA.

If you desire a ministry opportunity which will enable you to address both the physical and spiritual needs of your patients, with opportunities for evangelism and discipleship, please consider God's call to serve in Belize. The Presbyterian Medical Clinic receives an average of 25 patients daily with adult diabetes and hypertension being very prevalent among the population served.
