Thank you so much for your responses and prayers to our urgent prayer requests this month. God is good!

Amanda's dad- His blood has finally become anti-coagulated which means is at a level that can begin to dissipate the blood clot in his heart. His blood has to remain at this level for 2 more weeks for him to receive an ablation, which is a procedure which should fix his heart.

**Praise the Lord with us that with medication, my dad is able to live a normal life.**

**Please pray that his blood would remain at this level, that the blood clot would disappear and that this procedure would go well.**

Tito- our 14-year old pastor's son who has a brain tumor is finally going to be able to see a private doctor, Monday, May 19<sup>th</sup>. Up until this point, he has seen only public doctors and received less than mediocre care. There are many questions as to his tumor and if he will be able to have surgery.

**Praise the Lord for His grace in Tito's life as he always shows up with a smile on his face to church trusting that his life is in the Lord's hands. God has given Tito an incredible peace through all of this.**
