First of all we are no longer in the Chicago area where we had lived with a wonderful couple, the Christies, who opened their home and hearts to us for nearly two years. We thank the Lord for having brought them into our lives and for their friendship. We are now living in the Baltimore area, where we have yet again had an opportunity to see God's provision. The Phelps family has opened their guest home to us with about six acres of land in which the kids can play.

The Lord has also blessed us with partners in supporting our mission in Peru. We hope to have forty five to fifty percent of our support met by the end of winter. Please join us in prayer that the Lord will provide our full support by July. This is our tentative date of departure to Lima, Peru. We thank those of you who have joined us in this partnership which will enable us to take part in furthering His kingdom by mentoring young people as part of the church planting efforts in Lima.

I will be leaving for Lima December 27 with a short term mission team from Lancaster, Pennsylvania. I will have the opportunity of visiting the work in the hinterlands (Huanta), in which my wife and I were involved. We will be involved in a building project. I ask prayer for the protection of my wife and kids as they stay here in the states. We are also experiencing some residency challenges with Homeland Security as we try to get my wife's unconditional permanent visa. They are just doing their job but we pray that the Lord will expedite this process.
