Our Vision

The city of Lima is filled with all kinds of people. Some are natives to the large city, while others were sent there by family members in search of a "better life." Many of these people come from deep in the heart of the Andes mountains and have little city experience. Young Christians are particularly vulnerable in Lima because of the many temptations and worldly excitements that can distract them from their faith.

Our goal is to reach these young people in Lima, and provide them with a place to hear the Gospel and strengthen their faith. We hope to open up a community center with a computer lab, kitchen, and recreation room to draw young people in and share with them the love of Jesus Christ. Our short term goal is to have twelve faithful students who we mentor on a regular basis, who can then turn around and mentor others, like ripples in a lake. Our long term goal is to plant churches and hope to start many throughout the city and outskirts of Lima, which is where we will make our home.



Biography

Osman was born in Huanta, Peru. He attended Columbia International University and Covenant College. He served in the U.S. Armed forces for five years, first in Germany and later in Kuwait.

Having accepted the Lord as a young boy, Osman is a third-generation MTW missionary following the footsteps of his grandparents, Harry and Florence Marshall and of his parents, Gerry and Ruthie Gutierrez. For several years Osman worked as a volunteer in the Project Nehemiah Orphanage in Huanta. It was during this time that he met his wife.

Janett was also born in Huanta. She studied at the National University of San Cristobal de Haumanga where she majored in pharmacology and chemistry.

Osman and Janett attended a mentoring program where Janett came to know the Lord. They were married in 2002, and have three children, Gerardo, Esther, and Deborah.
