In August, Dick will again be teaching at Chattanooga State Technical College in Dayton and I will be looking for a nursing job. We are blessed to have an apartment in the home of a dear friend awaiting us, and the folks from our church will help us get moved in next week, shortly after we arrive in Dayton. Won't it be nice to get everything out of storage and have just one place to live after all the moving we have been doing in Peru.

How can you pray?

- That the Lord will help our co-translators Roberto and Waldemar see clearly how He wants them to serve Him now that they are no longer tied into our schedule. They had both been pastors when they started working with us, and having received a salary for over five years and then having that end is hard for them. Roberto is the director of the Kashinawa Bible Institute,

which is moving ahead well, and will probably thrive even more under his very astute leadership and burden for the evangelization of his people. Waldemar might also work in this ministry. Ask the Lord to place the desire in the hearts of the Kashinawa believers to help financially and with their energies in the evangelization of their people.

- For Dick and me as we travel this summer, sharing with friends, family and churches about our wonderful time with Mission to the World in Peru. We will leave the shorter trips in the TN area to when we actually settle in there. So, after we move our things out of storage, we will be gone for two months.

We thank you very sincerely for your loving and faithful prayers and your financial support for these years. Each of you is an important member of the Lord's team to the Kashinawas, and we are deeply grateful for your part. We are looking forward to seeing most of you soon.
